Dear Parents and Community Members,

Liberty received an Overall State Rating of Level 4, yet our 3rd-4th-5th grade students are performing better on the Oregon State Assessments and showing more growth than many elementary schools in Oregon.

Key Academic highlights

- 89% met/exceeded state standards for reading
- 81.2% met/exceeded state standards for math

Key Growth highlights

- Due to the laser-like focus on targeted math and reading interventions, significant measurable growth occurred in all students.
- Slower growth was seen in students who have a disability, or come

from poverty situations or are struggling with language acquisition.

During the 2013-14 school year, we will continue to focus on intensive intervention supports to ensure measurable growth for ALL students. We promise to continue to deliver the same excellence you have come to expect from Liberty. 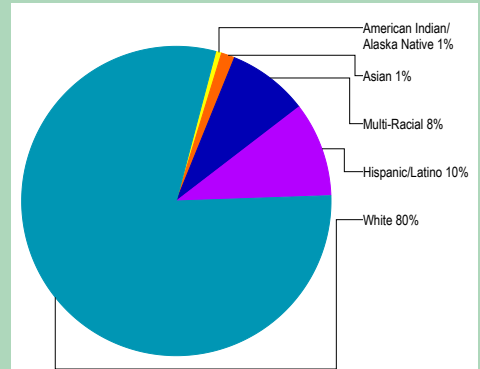

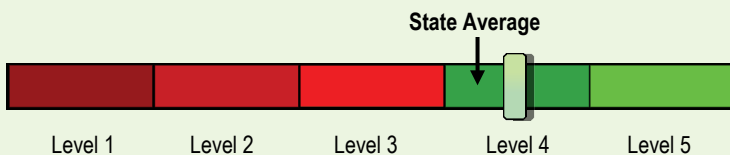


OVERALL STATE RATING

HOW ARE STUDENTS AT THIS SCHOOL PERFORMING COMPARED TO THOSE AT OTHER SCHOOLS?

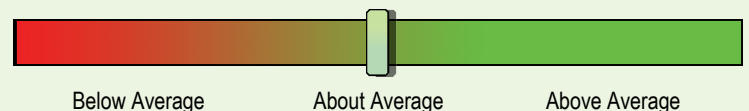

Compared to all schools statewide in 2012-13, this school is rated as Level 4.



- Level 1** = Falls into the bottom 5% of schools

- Level 4** = Falls between 44% and 90% of schools
- Level 5** = Falls into the top 10% of schools

- Above average** = Falls into the top third of comparison schools

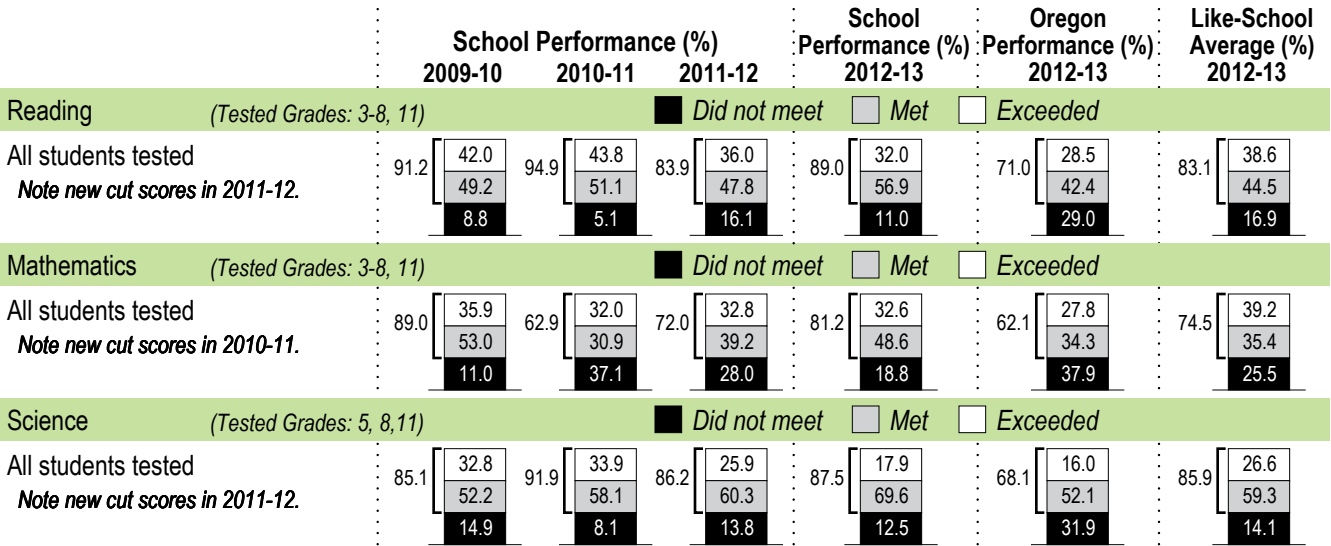
